AGENDA ITEM NAME: Continued discussion and Action on Pioneer Street at 35th Avenue Roundabout Design

SUMMARY/BACKGROUND:

At September's meeting, the Roundabout Committee continued discussion and proposed two roundabout design concepts with which to seek Council feedback. Feedback received during briefings the week of October 7 is below.

Overall, they really like the concepts, while Concept A was preferred, because:

- You can see the boat from all angles
- The multi-tier waves were more preferable than the slope.

Specific comments received included:

- Good height
- Concerns about the birds on posts being too tall (maintenance, longevity, maybe they should be "swimming/standing")
- Similar concerns about the children
- Will there be lighting (if no power to roundabout what about solar)?

Note on the last comment that there is no power currently extended to the roundabout center, but staff believes it could be connected through a nearby street light transformer.

Staff is also suggesting that the center components be raised so they are visible to vehicles above the level of the knee wall.

Attached are the two concepts currently under consideration.

Committee discussion and recommendation of a preferred concept (or up to two) to forward to City Council is requested.

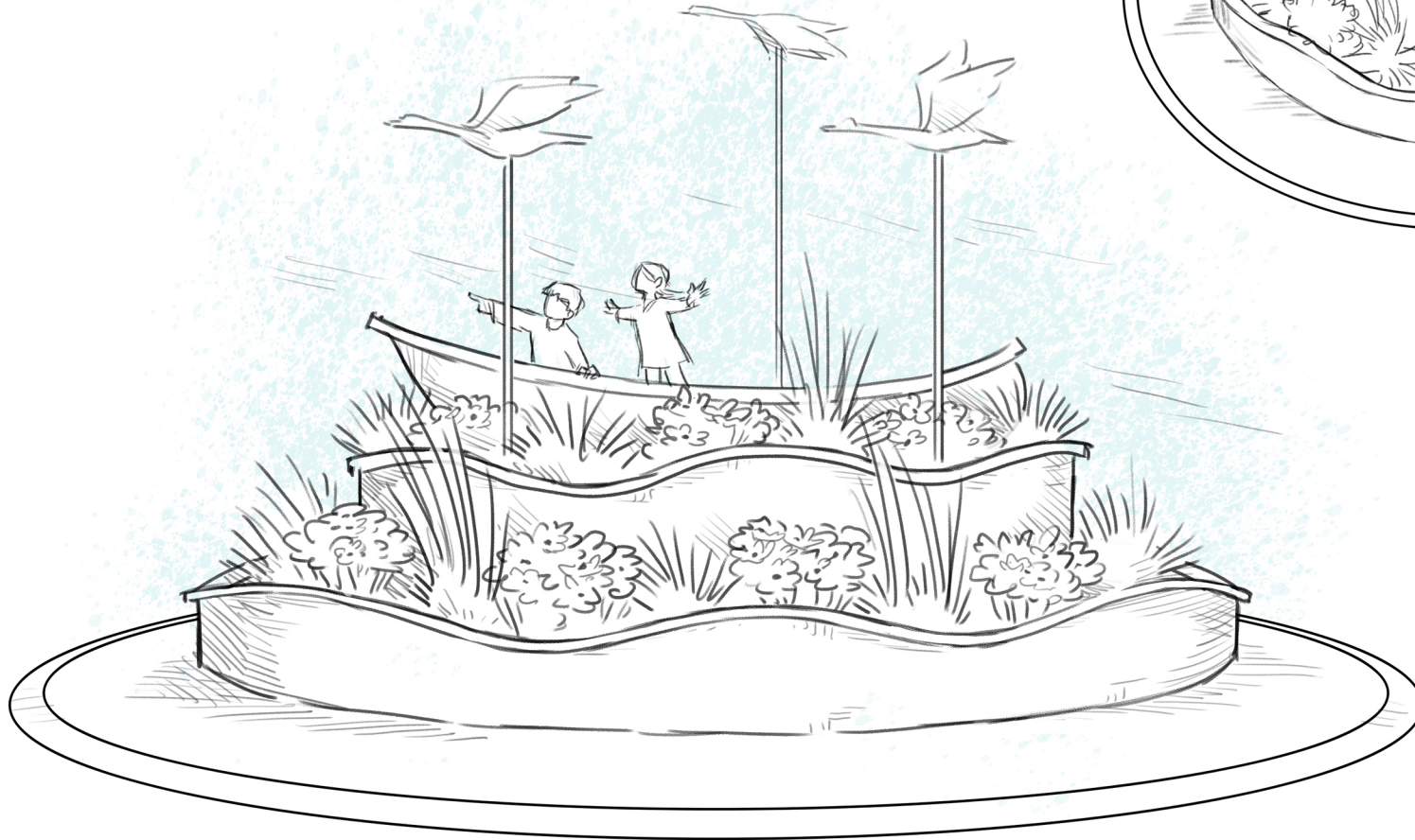

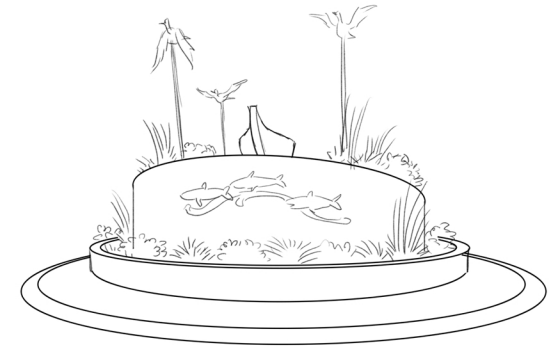
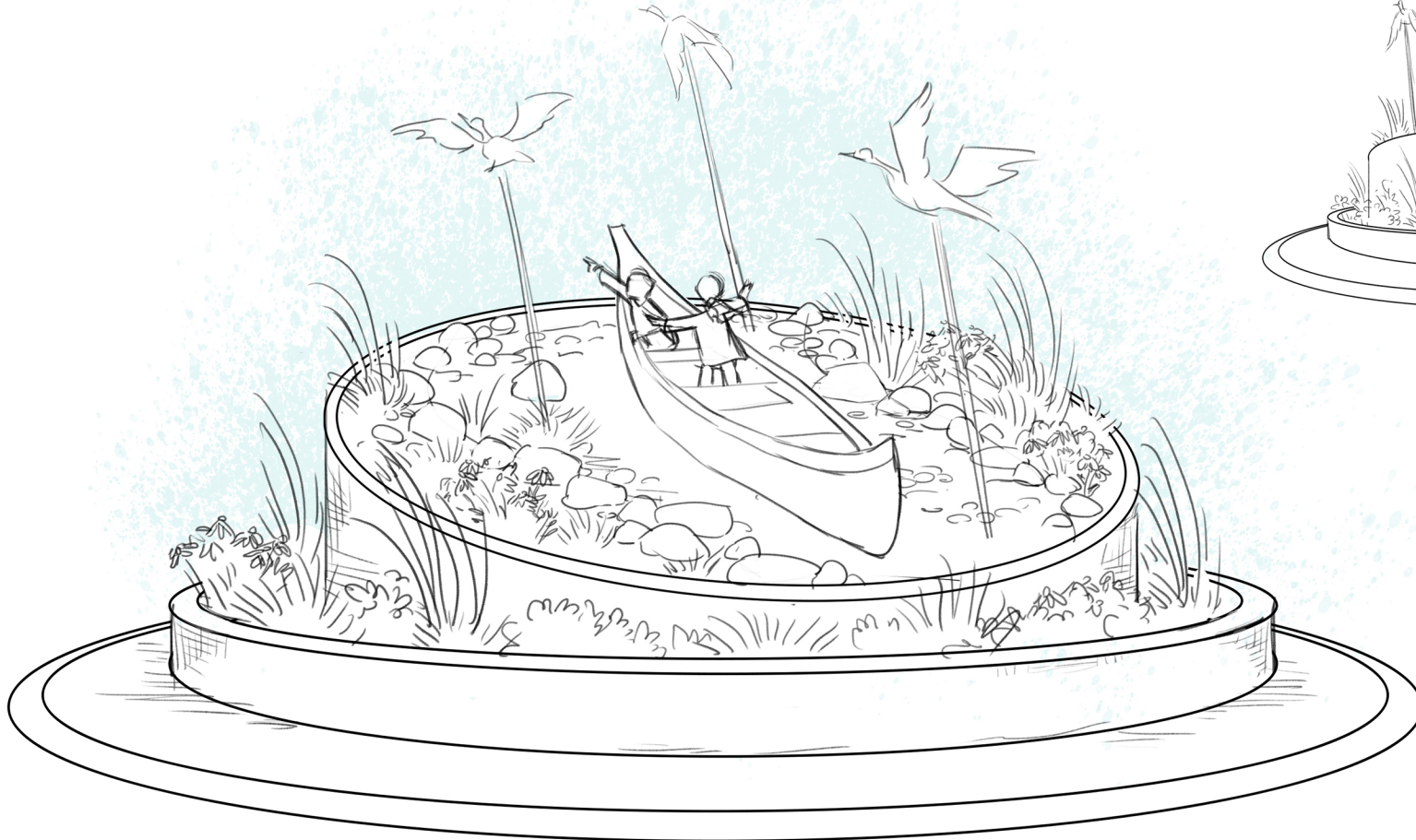
CONCEPT A



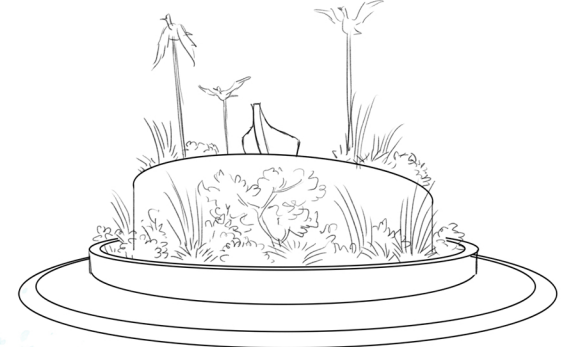
OVERHEAD VIEW
