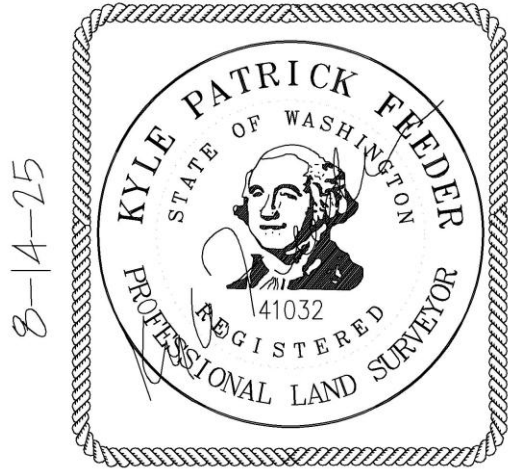

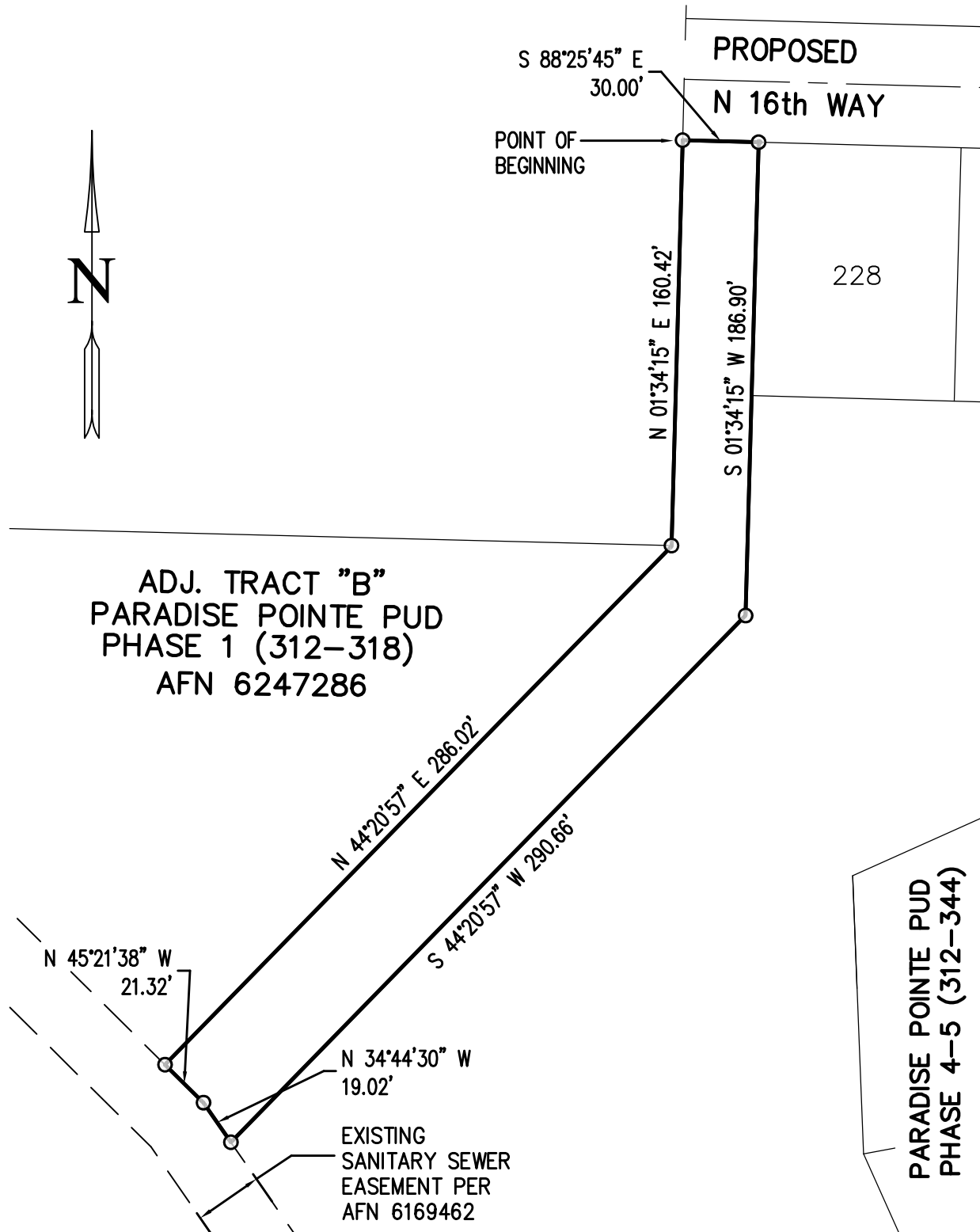

PREVIOUS COUNCIL ACTION TAKEN:

On July 22, 2021, City Council adopted a Statement of Legislative Intent (SLI) via Resolution No. 597, memorializing the purpose for 56th and 65th roundabout grapes, as well as policies requiring contractual agreements in place before work is accomplished on the project.

SUMMARY/BACKGROUND:

After multiple discussions between City Council and City staff from late 2014 to the present, City Council formally memorialized the purpose of grapes planted in the 56th and 65th roundabouts along SR501/Pioneer Street as follows: The Roundabout Grapes were planted as – and will continue to be – a reminder of and testament to the vibrant winemaking community in and around Ridgefield.

The City Council also memorialized a process for determining the use of the roundabout grapes each year. The first step in that process is to research possible vendors who would be willing to work with the City on creating a product from the grapes which will remain as public property for non-pecuniary uses.

In 2025, volunteers tending to the roundabout grapes contacted winemakers to assess interest in working with the City to store, process, and ultimately bottle wine from the marechal foch roundabout grapes. This led to contact and interest by Tom Sanchez of Columbia Ridge Winery. No other wineries replied to the requests.

If City Council chooses to proceed with selection of Columbia Ridge Winery as the 2025 roundabout grapes vendor, City staff will begin work with the vendor immediately to finalize a vendor agreement which will come before City Council.

BUDGET/FINANCIAL IMPACTS:

Staff time and materials associated with creating the vendor agreement. Additional costs associated with the vendor agreement (labor, processing costs, materials, etc.) will be itemized in the vendor agreement.

Parks Board Recommendation:

The Parks Board of Commissioners recommends City Council consider the following naming options, or appropriate variations, for the new Community Park within the Paradise Pointe PUD:

- **Allene Wodaeye Storybook Park**

This name honors the life and legacy of Allene Wodaeye, a devoted and tireless community leader in Ridgefield. The inclusion of “Storybook” recognizes her contributions to literacy, community connection, and the ongoing story of Ridgefield. This name reflects both personal legacy and community values.

- **Loowit View Park**

This name reflects the park’s striking views of Mount St. Helens and honors the original name of the mountain, “Loowit,” used by Indigenous peoples of the region. Incorporating this name pays tribute to the mountain’s cultural and historical significance while reinforcing a sense of place.

- **Wildflower Meadows Park**

This name highlights the park’s natural landscape and beauty, particularly its open meadows and potential for native wildflower plantings. It emphasizes the park’s intent to foster a deeper connection with the natural environment and invites residents and visitors to experience Ridgefield’s ecological character.

Hearing Synopsis:

The public hearing featured two testimonies. The first speaker proposed the name **Green Park** as a tribute to the City’s retiring Public Works Director, recognizing their long-standing service, leadership, and contributions to the development and care of Ridgefield’s public spaces. The speaker emphasized the importance of honoring individuals who have had a lasting impact on the community.

The second testimony was offered by two residents of the Paradise Pointe Planned Unit Development. They advocated for the name **Heron Hollow**, citing the site’s historic role as a habitat for local bird species, particularly herons. In addition to recognizing the park’s natural character, the speakers shared their fondness for alliteration, noting how “Heron Hollow” creates a memorable and fun name.

Board Discussion Synopsis:

The Parks Board held a discussion on the naming suggestions received through public testimony and the community survey.

Member Schill shared the background and legacy of longtime Ridgefield resident and community advocate Allene Wodaeye. She described Mrs. Wodaeye's dedication to literacy, youth programs, and civic engagement, highlighting her instrumental role in supporting the Ridgefield library, community center, and efforts to foster connection and goodwill throughout the city. Member Schill proposed the name Allene Wodaeye Storybook Park, combining her legacy with a nod to the storytelling and literacy work she championed.

Member Rafanelli proposed the name Loowit View Park, referencing the park's clear views of Mount Saint Helens and honoring the name "Loowit," which originates from Indigenous oral traditions and reflects the cultural and historical importance of the mountain to Native peoples of the region.

Member Galvan suggested Wildflower Meadows Park, inspired by the park's natural beauty and potential for native plant restoration. The name reflects the site's ecological character and reinforces the park's purpose as a place for connection to the natural environment.

Following discussion, the Board voted to forward all three names—with their respective rationales—for City Council's consideration, encouraging the selection of one of these options or a variation thereof for the official park name.

Considerations

- Neighborhood or boundary roads
- Natural or geographical features
- Cultural or historical significance
- Deceased individuals with outstanding civic service (1+ years)
- Contributing Organizations

General Restrictions

- Generally, not named after living individuals (unless part of a donation agreement)
- Name must not be offensive or inappropriate by community standards

Pre-Planning Process

- A Working Name is assigned by city manager or designee at acquisition
- Throughout planning process, staff initiate the naming procedure.

Public Process

- Community Input is solicited and recorded
- Parks Board conducts a Public Hearing
- Parks Board submits report to City Council
- City Council has final naming authority

Official Naming

- Council considers naming recommendation and adopts official name
- City Staff implement naming into communications and operations

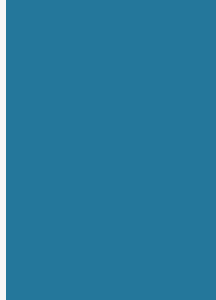
