1. Motion - Approval of Interlocal Agreement with Clark Regional Wastewater District

Revised Code of Washington Chapter 39.34 allows for governmental agencies to enter into interlocal agreements whereby each party can utilize the other party's services when it is determined to be in the best interest of both parties. The City of Ridgefield is beginning construction of improvements to Royle Road between Wells Drive and S. 19th Court, and has awarded the Construction Contract to NW Construction. Schedule C of the work is related to adjustment of the sanitary sewer force main within the project area. This interlocal agreement will provide a mechanism to allow the City to complete this work and for the District to reimburse the City for the costs associated with this work.

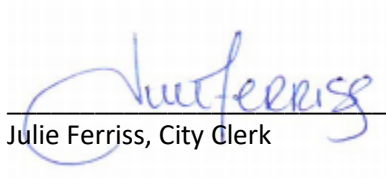

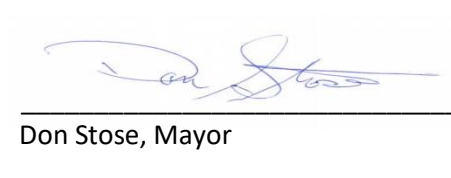
