Public Works Update

The City received additional grant funds for Osprey Park's play equipment. From the Parks Foundation we received \$65,000 and from the Nutter Foundation we received \$5,000.

2. Community Development Update

Bryan provided an update on upcoming development projects and associated parks and trails for the respective areas:

Ridgecrest (453 lots) east of 45th near S. 15th

Clover Hill (455 lots) west side of 45th, on S. 15th

Kennedy (280 lots) south of Ridgefield High School and Outdoor Recreation Center Project

Village at Canyon Ridge (23 lots) west of Pioneer Canyon and Green Gables

Teal Crest (65 lots) end of Sevier Road

Taverner Ridge Phase 10 & 11 (115 lots) will be smaller homes

Hillhurst Highlands (78 lots) across from Wishing Wells and next to Hawks Landing

Cedar Creek (31 lots) Between 32 and 35th Avenue, north of Green Gables

Quail Hill Phase 1 - Union Ridge area

3. Potential Parks Property Update

The City is working on purchasing the parcel north of 50th (between the two roundabouts) owned by the sewer district and two parcels on the Johnson property and will be seeking input from the Parks Board on ideas for this park. We are also looking in this same area for a large parcel to replace NP6.

The park area is smaller than the Board envisioned. The goal is to have a concept drawing done so construction can begin within the next year or so. Next step, Bryan will check on funding and bring information back to the Board with an update.
