1. Parks Advisory Board Partnership Meeting Update

The concept is that in working together we will be able to accomplish more than trying to compete for the same dollars. Mayor Onslow did a fantastic presentation on Ridgefield's

Outdoor Recreation Complex and Council Member Marc Boldt did a short presentation on Clark County Parks. The next meeting will be in Vancouver and everyone will receive an invitation.

2. Trail Naming - [6:37 PM](#)

Bryan Kast received a trail naming request from Roy Garrison and Cecil Hascal. Cecil Hascal is the son of Lewis Hascal who originally built Hascal Road. Hascal Road goes up the hill to Bellwood Heights and is adjacent to Reiman Road. Bryan read a letter from Cecil about his father's efforts in developing the road by hand. In honor of his father, Cecil requests that the road be renamed Hascal Trail. Staff recommends the Board make a motion on the proposed name and forward to City Council for their consideration.

Public Works Update

Ridgefield's Outdoor Recreation Complex - Plans for the grading work is under review by staff and will be going out to bid soon. Construction should start late July or early August. Right now the school is moving dirt. Ideally, our grading project would begin at the end of theirs. The city will continue working with the school district on the joint portions of this project and integration.

NW Hillhurst Road Water Main Extension Project - The project is going out to bid soon. Construction should begin late July or early August.

Osprey Park Play Ground - We were successful in obtaining a Parks Foundation Grant for a portion of this project. Today we submitted for a Nutter Foundation Grant, which should potentially fund the entire play equipment project.

Mobile Homes - The two mobile homes across from Ridgefield's Library are gone. The long-term goal includes a mixed used, governmental building. In the meantime, we will use it as a green space and park.

Dog Park - There is an Eagle Scout Project underway, it is a kiosk for the rule sign painted by Sondra Smith. The project will wrap up today or tomorrow morning. KGW will have a segment about it on tonight's news. In addition, a future Eagle Scout Project will include a couple of bench seats, which will also be a nice addition to the park.

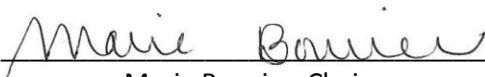
