Vice Chair Davis gave a report on improvement suggestions for the RORC that included a PowerPoint presentation. Improvements included adding padded backstops, permanent lines, lights, improved fencing solutions, batters eye screen, and mounts for scoreboards to various fields located on-site. Additionally, recommendations were made for adding a real-time reservation system, improving gates and access points during Raptor games, implementation of a new process for managing irresponsible users, and establishing a policy that allows priority users greater schedule flexibility.

to run the Parks Board meetings and would be focused on parks. This will be the first dedicated parks position.

Consultants have been selected for the Horns Corner Park master planning and for the Refuge Park design work. Both contracts will go to Council for approval tomorrow. There would be 2-3 concepts based on feedback over the last year that will be brought to the Parks Board and Council for final feedback. A preferred design will be selected around April. Master planning is targeted to be done the first quarter and then to construction for phase one, and have that construction completed by the end of the year. Boyse park is also planned for design. There is no construction funds planned for Boyse this year, work will just be on the planning effort.
